DROP OFF AND PICK UP ARRANGEMENTS



Drop off and pick up arrangements

- 1.Students' Safety: Traffic Marshals and the School Support team are at designated points at the school gates as well as around the school parking areas during pick-up and drop-off times to ensure efficient traffic flow and the safety of both our parents and students.
- 2.Traffic Management: Vehicles enter from Gate Number 2 at the front of the school and leave from Gates 1, 3 and 4 depending on the drop-off location of the student. Gates open at 07:00 am sharp to allow parents to gain access into the school building to drop-off their children.
- 3. Students' Segregation: designated entry and exit points are allocated to secure dedicated boys and girls supervised access points where female students enter and leave school through the main reception and male students in Year 5 and above enter and leave school through Door Numbers 4 and 6.

Drop Off

Students should be dropped off in the morning between 7:15 am and 7:40 am.

FS1 to Year 1 students: One accompanying adult with their parent or guardian lanyard can enter the school's building through Reception or the FS Entrance to drop off the student in FS or Year 1 corridor.

Year 2 to Year 13 students: Parents can drop off their children at the allocated entry points by the side of the main building. Please refer to the above table depicting drop off and pick up points. Year 2-12 parents can walk their child to the side dedicated entrance but are kindly requested not to enter the building.

Students will be considered **late from 7:45 am**. Late students should enter school through Main Reception except boys in Years 7-13. Boys in Years 7-13 should use their main entry point (Doors 4 and 6) until 8.00am and Main Reception after this.


Families with more than 1 child can drop off all children at the earliest allocated time; children will then go directly to their class where supervision will be in place from 7.15am.

PARENT LANYARD

Families must provide a passport sized photo of the adult(s) approved to obtain a parent lanyard to gain access to the school building to collect their children from school.

The school will provide two adults per family with a yellow parent lanyard to access school.

If you require additional lanyards for approved nannies/drivers to collect your child, please apply for this via our Reception or Admissions Team.

Additional lanyards can be made available for a cost of AED 20/- so long as they are for appointed adults to collect your child.

The person who is dropping off/picking up your child from school MUST always wear their parent/guardian lanyard from the moment of entering the school gate.

ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY PROCEDURES



SICKNESS AND UNEXPECTED ABSENCE

If you need to report an unexpected absence, i.e. due to sickness, please email attendance_gns@gemsedu.com before 7:15am, copying in your child's class/ form teacher.

If your child is unwell and absent from school for two days or more, you must provide a doctor's note before your child returns to school. Doctor's notes can be forwarded to the clinic email or given to the class/ form tutor on return.

Please note that all absences will influence the attendance percentages in student reports.

SCHOOL APPROVED LEAVE

All student vacations/ travel should strictly be kept within school closure times.

It is very unlikely that we will approve leave requests during term. We follow strict guidelines from the KHDA and can only approve leave in extreme circumstances. Should you wish to request leave for your child, please complete the leave request form at school reception. Any additional holiday leave must be approved by the Head of School and School Principal following a request of a Leave of Absence Form.

UNEXPLAINED ABSENCE

Parents will receive an automated email after completing the registers which includes updates on lates and sickness. If we haven't received an email from you before 7:15am, your child will automatically be marked as unauthorised which in turn will affect their attendance percentage. We will amend your child's record once you provide us with the reason or doctor's note.

EARLY COLLECTION REQUESTS

Early collection from school is not acceptable without a valid reason for safeguarding purposes. Parents are encouraged to try and make doctors' appointments etc. outside of school hours. Interrupting lessons is not only detrimental to the child's learning but that of the rest of the class too. If the child usually uses the Bus Service to go home, it is the parent's responsibility to contact the Bus Company to inform them that they will not be using the service. If a parent needs to collect their child early, an email to the Head of School and Class Teacher/Pastoral Lead 24 hours in advance is required. The email needs to include the date, time and reason for early collection.



BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE (Y2 - Y13)

- To support with learning, all children from Year 2 to Year 9 are requested to bring in an iPad and a pair of headphones every day.
- All students from Year 10 to Year 13 are requested to bring a laptop and headphones to school every day.
- Please ensure that your child's device and headphones are brought to school fully charged. Charging stations are provided to support battery life when needed, but these may be limited.
- Ensure the device has a protective case to avoid damage and breakages.
- Devices will only be used for educational purposes during lesson times.
- Make sure the device is labelled with your child's name and class.





STUDENT PHOTOS AND VIDEOS

At GEMS Al Barsha National School, our staff will regularly take photographs and videos on school devices to evidence and celebrate your child's learning. This may see your child involved in group and individual educational experiences, including school trips and performances. These photos and videos may be used on school displays, on our social media pages and, occasionally, for marketing purposes. If you do not wish for your child to be photographed or recorded in school, please request a 'Photograph and Video Non-consent Form' from your child class teacher.





SAFEGUARDING AND CHILD PROTECTION

Parents/carers are the most important people to keep their children safe. You should always:

- Wear your yellow parent lanyards at all times around school .
- Refrain from taking pictures of students who are not your own.
- Feel confident to speak to a staff member if you have concerns about a child's welfare.
- Feel confident to raise concerns about the conduct of other adults or students.
- Talk to the school if you need help or support Let the school
- know if your child has a medical condition.
- Let the school know if there is a change in your circumstances such as a house move, a new contact number, a change of name, a change of parental responsibility.
- Let the school know who will be dropping off or collecting your child and provide us with a total of two emergency contact names and numbers. You must inform the school of any changes to the agreed arrangements.
- Let the school know if your child is going to be absent and the reasons why.
- Let the school know if you have any court orders relating to the safety of your child.
- Read the school policies about Safeguarding available on the school's website.
